














Since 2006, the Fondation Monique-Fitz-Back has been promoting environmental and social awareness among Quebec youth. It supports initiatives that empower young people and strengthen their connection to nature and their community.

Through its Financial Assistance Program, it provides annual grants to educational institutions to support environmental and social projects.

GENERAL OBJECTIVES OF THE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (FAP)

- Support creativity and innovation in environmental education.
- Foster environmental and social engagement among youth.

AN ENHANCED PROGRAM FOR 2026

This year, the FAP has a total budget of \$120,000 to offer institutions, for projects that fall into five thematic initiatives.

- Climate Change initiative up to \$2,000 per project
- Waste Management | RECYC-QUÉBEC initiative up to \$2,000 per project
- Outdoor Education Support initiative up to \$500 per project
- Social Cohesion initiative up to \$500 per project
- Youth Committees initiative up to \$500 per project (new!)

\$50,000 budget - up to \$2,000 per project

Examples of projects include:

- Educating students on cycling as a means of transportation through fun activities
- Artistic creation projects about climate issues
- Development of a green space and vegetable garden

WASTE MANAGEMENT | RECYC-QUÉBEC INITIATIVE

\$35,000 budget - up to \$2,000 per project

Examples of projects include:

- Overconsumption Awareness Week
- Reduction of single-use plastics (plates, cups)
- Installation of recycling and/or organic waste sorting equipment



OUTDOOR EDUCATION SUPPORT INITIATIVE

\$20,000 budget - up to \$500 per project

Examples of projects include:

- Creation of a nature alphabet book
- Outdoor reading and writing
- Practising math and measurements while being active outside

SOCIAL COHESION INITIATIVE

\$5,000 budget - up to \$500 per project

Examples of projects include:

- Facilitation of activities promoting Indigenous cultures or cultural diversity at school
- Invited guest to lead training on deconstructing prejudice

\$10,000 budget - up to \$500 per project

Examples of projects include:

- Organization of a training day for the committee
- Purchase of committee member identification materials (shirts, caps, etc.)
