Since 2006, the Fondation Monique-Fitz-Back has been promoting environmental and social awareness among Quebec youth. It supports initiatives that empower young people and strengthen their connection to nature and their community.

Through its Financial Assistance Program, it provides annual grants to educational institutions to support environmental and social projects.

GENERAL OBJECTIVES OF THE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (FAP)

- Support creativity and innovation in environmental education.
- Foster environmental and social engagement among youth.

AN ENHANCED PROGRAM FOR 2027

This year, the FAP has a total budget of \$127,550 to offer institutions, for projects that fall into four thematic initiatives.

- **Climate Change initiative** - up to \$2,000 per project
- **Waste Management | RECYC-QUÉBEC initiative** - up to \$2,000 per project
- **Outdoor Education Support initiative** - \$500 per project
- **Youth Committees initiative** - up to \$500 per project

Deadline to submit a project.

JANUARY 2027

Applicant institutions notified of accepted projects

OCTOBER 20, 2027

Deadline to submit final project report with three copyright-free photos.

\$37,550 budget – up to \$2,000 per project

Examples of projects include:

- Overconsumption Awareness Week
- Reduction of single-use plastics (plates, cups)
- Installation of recycling and/or organic waste sorting equipment



OUTDOOR EDUCATION SUPPORT INITIATIVE

\$30,000 budget – up to \$500 per project

Examples of projects include:

- Creation of a nature alphabet book
- Outdoor reading and writing
- Practising math and measurements while being active outside



YOUTH COMMITTEES INITIATIVE

Examples of projects include:

- Organization of a training day for the committee
